Dear Students



You have been selected to take part in a special project on board *Cutty Sark*. Your teacher thinks you are highly skilled in questioning, discovering, selecting and justifying – these skills are very important for this project.

Cutty Sark has a water leak which desperately needs repairing, the leak will cost £1million to fix. In order to get the money to save the ship, it needs to be proven that Cutty Sark is important and interesting. A team of historical investigators with skills in questioning, discovering, selecting and justifying are the only ones that can prove Cutty Sark is worth saving. Your teacher thinks that you are the right team for this job!

Before you investigate on board, take a few minutes to think about why some things (such as objects/artworks/buildings) are saved? What is important and interesting about them? Should all old things be saved? How do we decide what to save and what not to save? Share your ideas.

There are three reasons I think *Cutty Sark* is important and interesting...

- Connection to the world Cutty Sark travelled the world carrying cargo over a hundred years ago
- People in the past Ordinary people in the past lived and worked on it
- Technology Cutty Sark is a sailing ship (it had no engine), it was built to carry cargo but to also be very fast

Now onto your mission – you are going to look around *Cutty Sark* and find evidence that helps us to prove that *Cutty Sark* deserves to be saved. You can do this by reading the signs, looking at the objects, chatting to crew members (Visitor Assistants) and watching the videos on board. Each level tells many different stores about *Cutty Sark* – choose the bits that you find most interesting and make notes/ drawings on your trail sheet. (If you're not sure which bits to choose, think about what you find interesting, you can use my suggestions if you like– connections to the world, people in the past or technology)

Please gather you evidence and present a report to your teacher on your return to school.

Good luck, the fate of Cutty Sark is in your hands!
