## Sensory Seas Session Outline



## Way haul Away! We'll haul away together. Way haul away! We'll haul away now!

**Sensory Seas** is a multi-sensory museum session developed especially for school groups with SEND.

In this session, one of our SEND facilitators will take on the role of Dot the Explorer. The museum would like Dot to travel to North America to bring back objects for the museum's collection. Your pupils can become explorers too and embark on a sailing trip around the world with Dot.

We use song, rhyme, role-play and object handling to discover new objects from unknown lands. Participants can choose which objects and correlating PECS symbols to bring back with them. Individuals can then choose which objects they would like to put on display for the museum director. Children will come into contact with objects that relate to sailing, North America, Antarctica and Australia. Sessions are **FREE** and usually last 40 minutes. You will also have the opportunity to book the Ahoy! Gallery exclusively for your group.

## **Curriculum links**

**Geography and history**- explorers, countries from around the world.

**Music and Drama** – singing, playing percussion instruments and role play.

**Literacy** – storytelling and narrative structure.

**Science** – transport, cold/hot rough/smooth.

**Social and independence skills** – working as a team, making choices.
