

# H.M.S Victory

1. Cut out all the pieces of the ship around the thick black lines.

2. Fold the hull lengthways along the three dotted lines, so it forms a W, like this...



3. Glue, staple or sellotape the front end of the hull, so it is pinched together like this...



4. Fold the two 'stern tabs' inwards and glue them to the back flap like this...



5. Push down the central fold. The hull should now look like this.



6. Glue the left and right sides of the ship to the hull. The two sides will meet at the front around the bow.

7. Glue the tabs on the sails and rigging inside the hull, so the bowsprit lines up with the bow.



8. Fold along the dotted lines of the back stern piece. Glue the stern piece onto the glue tabs marked on the hull.



Now hurry to the Cape of Trafalgar and fight the French and Spanish fleets!
