## **RMG Photography Policy**

## **Non-Commercial Photography**

Visitors are permitted to take non-commercial photographs, video and sound recordings for personal use within the grounds and galleries of Royal Museums Greenwich. This encompasses the National Maritime Museum, Royal Observatory Greenwich, the Queen's House and Cutty Sark. Some exclusions will apply in galleries, managed by the Visitor and Sales team, at their discretion.

We encourage and welcome the sharing of photographs on social media and with friends and family, though we ask that all visitors show consideration for other visitors and staff by not taking photographs without prior permission.

Photography and video using drones (UAV's), a tripod, monopod, flash and supplementary lighting is strictly forbidden. 'Super' selfie sticks are not to be used in the galleries.

Restrictions may also apply where items are on loan or have copyright restrictions and we will try wherever possible to make this clear in our signage, but. visitors should be aware that that it is their responsibility to ensure no copyright is infringed.
