# **Description**

This compass was made in Great Yarmouth in the 1920s for a Great Yarmouth vessel that was made in the port. Compasses have been a valuable tool for sailors for centuries. Compasses were vital for navigating the seas; without one you could be lost at sea! The Vikings had the first compasses, called a Uunatoq, which helped them sail across the North Atlantic.
