

GREENWICH RESIDENTS' INFORMATION SUNDAY 22 AUGUST 2021

Road closures from 06:00 to 16:00 on Sunday 22 August

The information provided in this leaflet is supplementary to The Vitality Big Half Road Closure Information booklet.

Please make sure you have read the booklet, which is available at **thebighalf.co.uk/road-closures**

The Vitality Big Half is a one - day festival centred around a half marathon running event. The event route will enter Greenwich from Evelyn Street, pass through Creek Road and finish at Cutty Sark.

If you require access either north or south of Creek Road between 08:50 and 15:00, please move your vehicle to the required side of the event route prior to 08:50 on Sunday 22 August. Road closures to the east of Greenwich will be in place from Blackwall Lane but stewards will assist if you need to access your premises.

Creek Road will open as soon as it is safe to do so to allow access to Deptford Church Street and Evelyn Street. Greenwich Town Centre will remain closed to through traffic until 16:00.

Vehicle Crossing Point 1

Creekside – Gonson Street and Glashier Street Closed for runners from **08:55** to **15:15**

Vehicle Crossing Point ¹³ Norman Road – Norway Street Restricted access from 08:55 to 15:15

Parking restrictions

If you have a vehicle, please move it from the event route on Saturday 21 August. All parking bays on the route will be suspended and vehicle removal will commence from 04:00 on Sunday 22 August.

Thames Tideway – Norman Road Closure

We are working with Thames Tideway to enable the existing road closure for the construction site to be open and available for residents to use on Sunday 22 August to access otherwise landlocked areas.

This also allows us to maintain vehicle crossing point 18, which will operate during the timings shown on the previous page.

Welland Street

Due to the large number of residents in and around Welland Street, vehicle access will be permitted onto Creek Road. You will be directed to join Vehicle Crossing Point 18 at Norman Road – Norway Street via the Thames Tideway site until 08:55.

On - foot access is available to allow pedestrians to cross Creek Road. Some local parking bays will be suspended and vehicle removals will commence from 04:00 on Sunday 22 August.

Park Row (south)

Access to Park Row on Sunday 22 August is restricted but stewards will facilitate access to this area if you arrive from Blackwall Lane.

Haddo Street

Haddo Street to Roan Street will be closed to traffic from 12:30 to 15:30 on Sunday 22 August. Parking bays will be suspended from 00:01 and any remaining vehicles will be relocated from 11:30. Please help us by parking your vehicle on a different road on the day. All relocated vehicles can be found via the website trace. london.

King William Walk (south)

Pedestrian and vehicle access is available throughout the day and local businesses will operate as usual. Stewards will facilitate access to this area.

Greenwich Town Centre

Local businesses, Greenwich Market, and Greenwich foot tunnel will be open as usual. The University of Greenwich will be open as usual and vehicles will be able to access the car parks on Park Row but only by approaching via Trafalgar Road.

Greenwich Visitor Centre, the Painted Hall and the University will be accessible on foot via signposted walking routes. Visitors are advised to allow additional time to walk to these areas.Local bus services from Romney Road to Greenwich High Road will be operating through the road closures. River boat services will operate as normal.
