Ensure your teaching is inclusive of ethnically diverse and global communities.

Endorse British values of democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty, mutual respect and tolerance of each other regardless of beliefs and faith.

Promote frequent cultural visits for non-art subjects to support a rich, broad and balanced curriculum.

Engage with heritage and artworks as a stimulus to unlock voices and develop a life-long love of learning.

Elicit insightful class discussion to develop a deeper understanding and confidence to articulate ownership of ideas.

Develop meaningful partnerships with the cultural sector:

to broaden appreciation

to strive for innovation and provide authentic opportunities

to take ownership of your students learning and ensure it is relevant and exciting

to highlight creative and culture pathways and progression routes

to identify and signpost networks to support coursework demands

to provide memorable learning experiences

Shared language across the school at all levels and for all stakeholders.

Show and exhibit outcomes in professional spaces to elevate classroom work.
