

SENsory Sailors: Visual Guide

When you get to the Museum

'SENsory Sailors' is a fun workshop created for families to join in with. It takes place during the National Maritime Museum's opening hours.

SENsory Sailors starts at 11:00am.



We recommend coming to the Romney Road entrance of the Museum.



When you come in

When you come in, a member of staff will ask if you have tickets. Let them know that you have arrived for SENSory Sailors and they will show you where to go. You don't need other tickets today.

By the entrance you can also find the toilets.

The Group Space

SENSory Sailors takes place in the Group Space. This is right by the Romney Road entrance to the Museum. It is the first door on the right after you come in.

The door to the Group Space is automatic. To enter, press the button by the door.

The Group Space has a laminate tile floor and windows that allow natural light into the space. There are some soft and hard benches in the space and other seating can be provided.



People you may meet



Visitor Experience staff wear blue uniform. They also wear a badge and carry a radio.



Learning staff and volunteers will be around throughout and they all wear badges.



The facilitator running the session is called Cash.



The facilitator helping to run the session is called Gaby.

Anyone who works at the Museum can help if there are any problems.

During SENSory Sailors

11.00—11.15 Arrive and come to the Group Space. You can use the toilet, have a drink, put your coats and bags away and get ready to start.

11.15—11.30 Welcome! Name signs and introduction to what we will be doing.

11.30—12.15 Making and activities

12.15—12.30 Sharing

12.30 Finish and home time



If you need to take a break and have a quiet moment at any point, speak with a member of the team and they will show you where to go.

If you need to leave the room during the session, your adult will go with you. You can take a walk around the Museum and come back when you are ready. You must stay with your adult.

If you need a movement break during the session, let a member of the team know and they can help with some activities.

Calmer spaces



If we all need to leave the Museum quickly:

If we need to leave quickly during SENSory Sailors, you will hear an alarm ringing in the building. That means we all need to leave the building quickly and calmly. Just follow a member of staff or these signs.
