

## Access to the Royal Observatory for Daytime Events

The Royal Observatory is situated in the centre of Greenwich Park. Please read the following information carefully to understand how to get to the Observatory. Please aim to arrive at least 15 minutes before your event starts, making your way to the Peter Harrison Planetarium Building, which is marked 2 on the map below and staff will direct you further.

## a) How to access the Royal Observatory on foot:

On foot, you can walk through the park to and from the Royal Observatory using any gate.

## b) How to access the Royal Observatory by car:

By car, you can drive through the park to the Royal Observatory using Blackheath Gate (marked b).


## **Getting to Greenwich**

DLR station Cutty Sark (5 minutes)
