When you get to the Museum

When you come in

When you come inside the Museum, a member of staff will welcome you. You can let them know that you have arrived for SENsory Sailors and they will show you where to go.

The door to the Learning Space is automatic. To enter, press the button by the door.

The Learning Space has a plastic floor. The windows are covered. There are some plastic benches in the space and other seating can be provided.

During SENsory Sailors
