Supervision - Pupils must be accompanied at all times:

KS1 one adult for every five pupils KS2 one-to-eight KS3 & KS4 one-to-ten

- Take time to explore the galleries at a leisurely pace, no need to run.
- No food or drink in the galleries please.

If you have pre-booked a lunch space please ensure you allow time to clean the tables and floor before the end of your slot. Lunch slots last 30 minutes. If you don't have a lunch space at the Museum we recommend the park in fine weather or under the collonades if it's raining.
