

SENsory Sailors: Visual Guide

When you get to the Museum

'SENsory Sailors' is a fun workshop created for families to join in with. It takes place during the National Maritime Museum's opening hours.

SENsory Sailors starts at 11:00am.



We recommend coming to the Romney Road entrance of the Museum.



When you come in

When you come in, a member of staff will welcome you. Let them know that you have arrived for SENsory Sailors and they will show you where to go.

The Group Space

SENsory Sailors takes place in the Group Space. This is right by the Romney Road entrance to the Museum. It is the first door on the right after you come in.

The door to the Group Space is automatic. To enter, press the button by the door.

The Group Space has a laminate tile floor and windows that allow natural light into the space. There are some soft and hard benches in the space and other seating can be provided.

At any time you can leave the session to go home or explore the museum, we don't mind. If you need to leave the room during the session, your adult must stay with you. You can come back whenever you're ready.

A sensory tent will be available in the room during the workshop. You can use this whenever you want.

The session will finish at 12.30pm.

If you need to take a break and have a quiet moment at any point, speak with a member of the team and they will show you where to go.
