There are toilets on the ground floor of the museum.

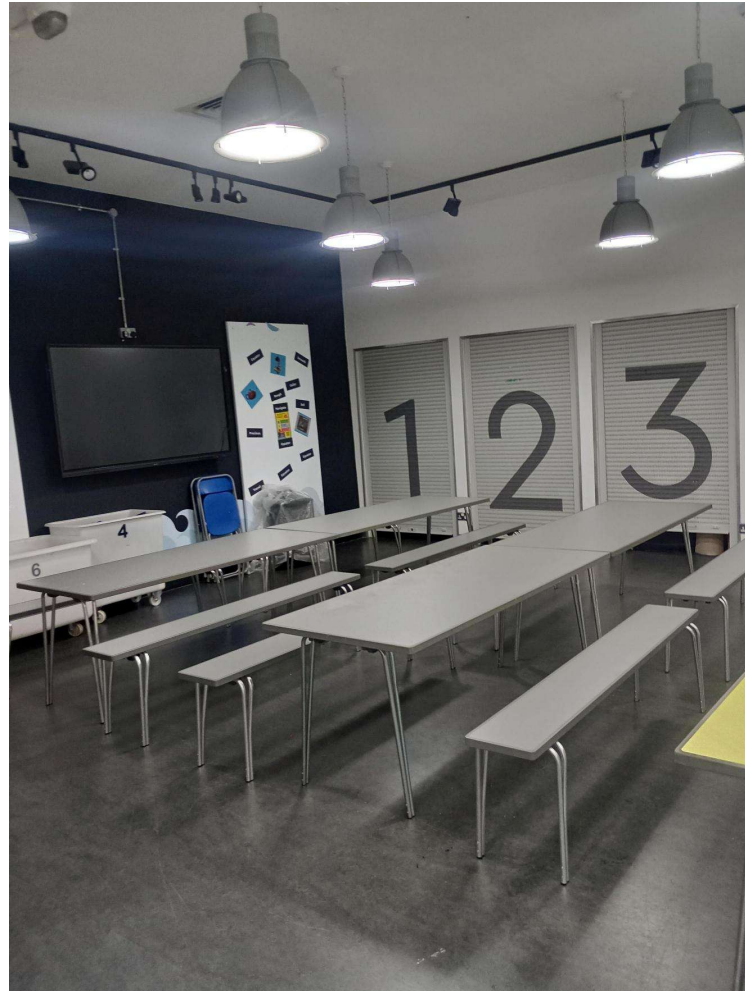


I will go to the Lecture Theatre and watch a show called 'Unboxing the Universe'.

The show will have noises, smells and bright lights.



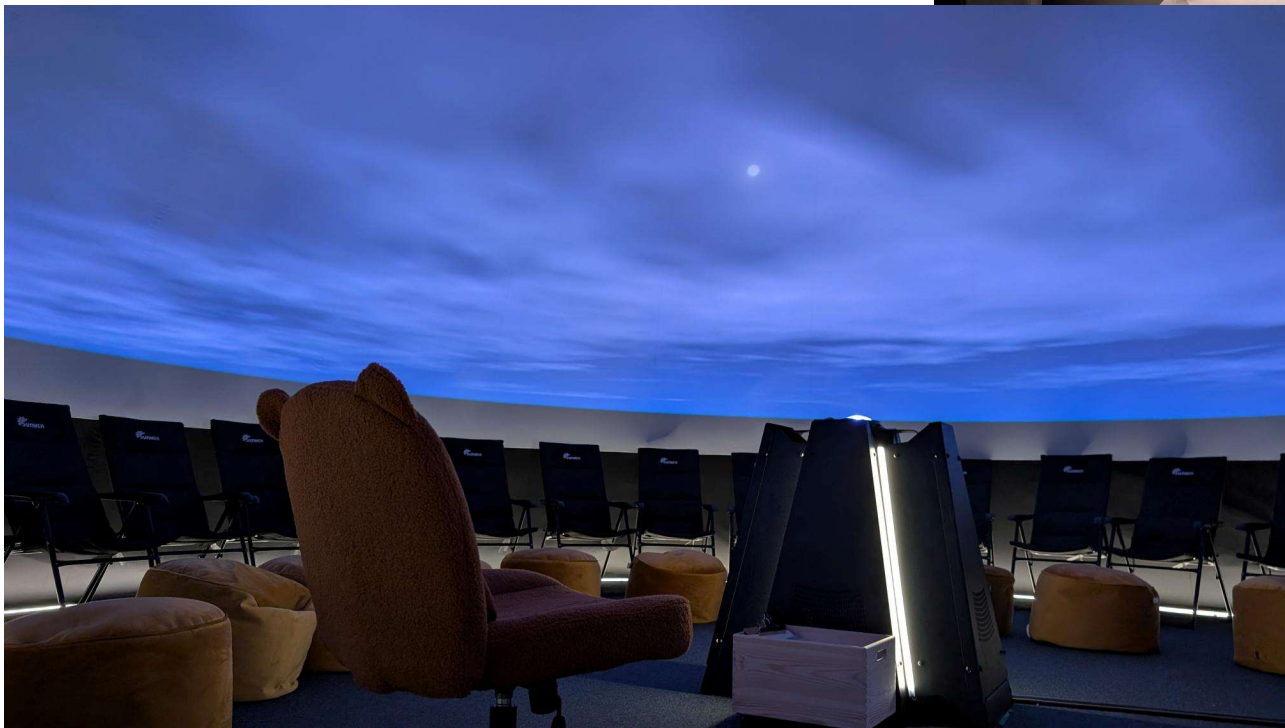
This is where I'll have my lunch.

I will go to the 'Astronomers Take Over' exhibition.

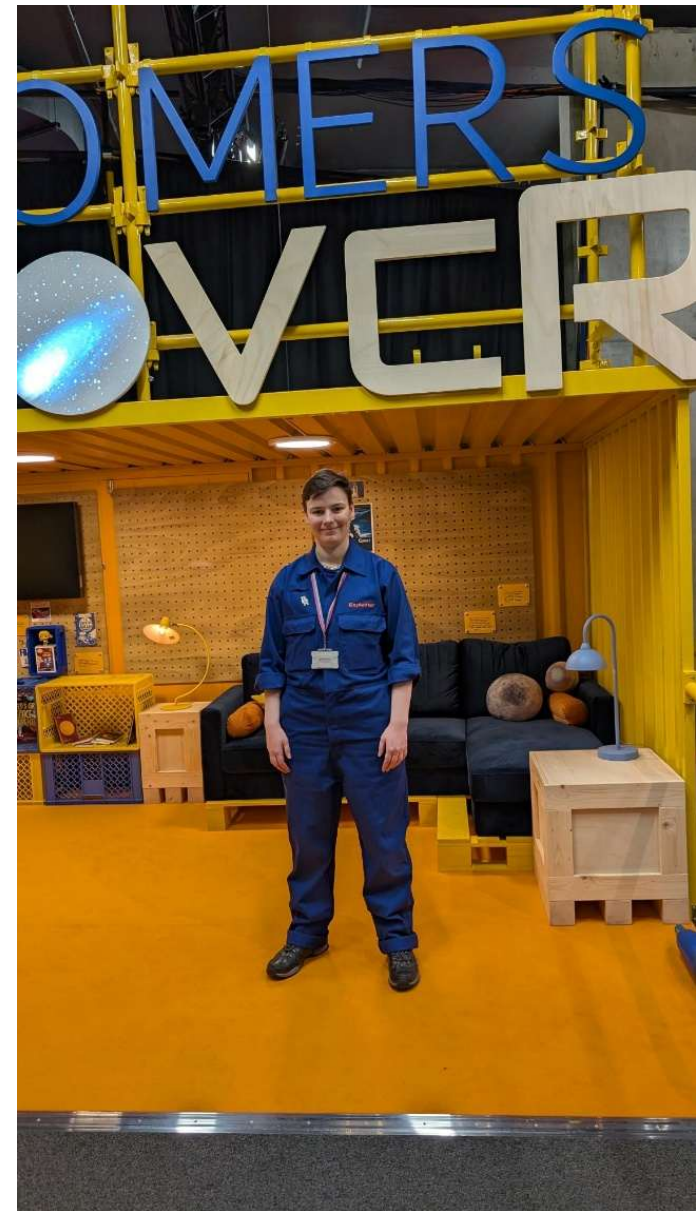
In this room there are friendly Explainers who are dressed in blue.
