Facilitated sessions

Early Years Foundation Stage

All aboard the story ship*

Using our figurehead collection, learn about how the ship got its name through storytelling, song, dance, and art and design. Finish your visit with a self-guided tour of the ship for further story-telling inspiration.

A sailor went to sea*

Join Jack the rat when he sneaks aboard *Cutty Sark* on his first-ever voyage. Explore together and help him learn new sailor skills.

Key Stage 1

All aboard the story ship*

Practise sailor skills with our wise old figureheads, then set sail for a voyage of discovery and adventure.

Key Stage 2

Inspired by the letter of a young apprentice, groups will explore props and clues before recreating a journey at sea through role play.

Sailors and stevedores – STEM

Don't tip the ship! Work scientifically to build boats and investigate how much weight can be added to your boat before it sinks.

Ships, maps and trade: the 'Great Tea Race'

Set sail on an exciting journey from Victorian London to China and study maps and images to find out what life was like for merchant sailors.

Workshops last for one hour. 10.15-11.15 | 11.45-12.45 | 13.00-14.00 Finish your visit with self-directed time.

£140 per group for facilitated workshops. Each workshop accommodates up to 30 children. It is possible to book self-directed time at the National Maritime Museum.
